The County of Sonoma Planning Department will present information about a proposed Scenic Corridor for HWY 128. The proposal is being designed to limit hillside development and to create guidelines and expectations for building and landscaping within the area designated for the Scenic Corridor. Development limits suggested could impact billboards, site pads for building, landscaping mandates and easements/roads. There are Scenic Corridors in many states including California.

The entire Corridor would extend from Mendocino through Napa Valley. The Sonoma County Planning Department is only concerned with the area from the Mendocino border to the Napa border. You most likely have driven through a Scenic Corridor; they are marked by a poppy icon.

The county is currently looking for feedback, ideas and suggestions from the folks within the area of the proposed Scenic Corridor. Healdsburg, Cloverdale and Geyserville are all within the scope of the Scenic Corridor.

This is important and the decisions made will be for the long run so be there to listen, learn and help give feedback so that the process works for everyone!
